Note - Questions numbered 1 to 10 are related to the history, Pre-history, archaeology and royal dynasties of Madhya Pradesh. You have to read the questions and write the correct answer in the answer booklet against the question number.

1. This temple was built along with other 24 temples in the famous tourist place Ashapuri, about 1300 years ago, during the Parmar period. The remains of this temple were found during the excavation in the year 2010. Recently, the State Archaeological Department has restored the glory of the temple by reconstructing it. What is the name this temple?
2. In which tourist place near Bhopal, Rani Mahal and Chaman Mahal have been renovated for increasing tourism activities?
3. This place, famous for the caves of Shaiv, Vaishnav and Jain sects, is one of the most important archaeological sites of Madhya Pradesh. This site is close to a world heritage site. There are twenty caves in this cave complex. What is the name this site?
4. This cave complex, situated in Raisen district is considered a valuable chronicle of human history and a rich archaeological collection. Here, more than 500 caves depict the fascinating activities of the daily life of prehistoric cave dwellers. What is the name of the cave complex?
5. This stepwell was built in the ancient fort of Hatta village in the 17th-18th century by Gond King Hatte Singh Valke for soldiers to hide, drink, bathe and relax during summers. This stepwell has been declared a protected monument by the Archaeological Department. In which district is this Hatta stepwell located?
6. These stupas are also known as Bhojpur Stupas. They are a group of 37 stupas and two Buddhist temples located 11 km from Sanchi. They were discovered in the 19th century by an Englishman named Major Cunningham. The stupas contain relict chests/boxes containing the remains of Buddhist teachers and disciples. What is the name of this stupa?
7. Located at a depth of eighty feet in Burhanpur, Madhya Pradesh, this water system is a marvel of engineering. Near it, are springs flowing throughout the year, ancient Shiva temple and the invincible Asirgarh fort. What is the name of this water system?
8. Bagh Caves are a group of nine rock-cut monuments, located in Dhar district of Madhya Pradesh. A stone inscription of King Subandhu of Mahishmati has been found at the site of Cave no- 2, which mentions his donation for the repair of the Vihar. By what name is the inscription known?
9. This temple built by Veersingh Dev in 1622 AD in Orchha presents a unique style of architecture. This temple is dedicated to the goddess of wealth and prosperity, but there is no idol of any goddess inside the temple. 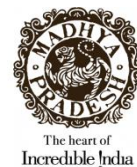
71. These caves of Morena district are prehistoric caves of 25,000 years ago. They are also known locally as *Likhichhaj*. What is the name of these caves?
72. These caves were built in the first century BC in the present Anuppur district. These are a group of five artificial rock-cut caves. Out of which only 3 caves Durvasa Cave, Cheri-Goddi Cave and Sitamarhi Cave are left and there are inscriptions on them. What is the name of these caves?
73. This cave/caves is located in Patni village of Raisen district. It was discovered in 2008-09. It is a mysterious cave which is more than one kilometer long. This cave is very narrow at the entrance. What is the name of this cave?
74. These caves of 7th century AD are located in Chandwasa village in Mandsaur district of Madhya Pradesh. It is a Buddhist pilgrimage site. It also has 1 Brahmanical cave.
