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Section 1

From - Question 1 to 10 pertain to the History, Archaeology and dynasties of Madhya Pradesh. Read them carefully and write the answers in your answer sheet.

1. The residence of the erstwhile queen of Maheshwar of 18th Century was by the banks of the Narmada. This Fort is also a tourist attraction. Many cenotaphs may be seen in the premises of this Fort. You have to tell the name of the Fort.
2. There is a tale about this area of Harda district that Rishi Jamadagni and Sahsra Arjun of Hehay dynasty had met here. This place has been described as the 'Malwa Sube Ki Sarkar' in 'Ain-e-Akbari.' This place is situated at the bank of Narmada river and is famous for ancient Riddhnath temple, Gurudwara, the tomb of Mullah Do Pyaza- one of the nine gems of emperor Akbar and Fort of Joga. What is the name of this place?
3. The temples built here by Parmar King Udayaditya are contemporary to the temples of Khajuraho. Here is a group of 12 temples. At a short distance from here, Mahalaxmi temple is situated towards the south and Balleshwar temple is situated towards north -west. The Shantinath temple and Gwaleswar temple are also situated here. The Jains consider this place as a place of Nirvana. What is the name of this place?
4. The center of Sanskrit study established by Raja Bhoj is situated here along with a temple of Goddess Saraswati. The statue of a meditating Goddess Vagdaevi is considered amongst the finest art pieces of the world although, the statue now lies in the London Museum. What is the name of the place ?

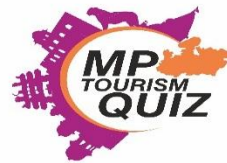
