36. The...... is believed to be the pearl amongst the fortresses of India. This palace fort holds special significance in the First Movement of Independence of 1857. According to inscriptions, it was constructed in the year 525 AD by king Surya sen. The fort has five entry gates.



- 37. was constructed by Raja Veer Singh Bundela in the 16th century. The Chaturbhuj temple, Ram temple, Lakshmi Narayan temple all are situated within the precincts of this Fort. According to historical sources, Mughal Emperor Jahangir also constructed Jahangir Mahal within the precincts of this Fort.
- 38. The......fort of Madhya Pradesh was constructed in the year 1344 AD by Sultan Muhammad Bin Tughlaq of Tughlaq dynasty and was later renovated by Abdul Shah. Tomb of Changash and Kharbuja Mahal are situated within this Fort. In the year 1732, the Marathas and Pawer Kings overpowered this fort.
- 39. The......Fort of Madhya Pradesh was constructed by Emperor Alauddin Khilji of Khilji dynasty in the 14 century AD. Located by the Shivna river, the wall of this Fort has images of Hindu Gods and Goddesses. The 500-year-old Tapeshwar Mahadev temple is also located here. After the Khilji dynasty this fort was related with Kachwaha, Tomar and Jaipur rulers.
- 40. The......Fort of Madhya Pradesh was founded by King Veer Singh Judev of Bundelkhand in the year 1626AD. Later Maharaja Bhawani Singh had the words 'justice is the gem of crown' engraved at the entry gate of this Fort. The interior comprises of murals of rhinoceros and elephants while the other wall has a head of Hippo bird hanging on it.

Later on, the collector Inamatullah who was a known devotee of Lord Rama, promoted this fair. You have to guess the name of this fair.
- 52. This Grand fair is organised in the Devi temple of Ghogra village situated in district Sidhi. It is believed that Birbal who was among the nine jewels of Akbar was a resident of this place.
- 53. A 15day long fair is held in the Bhairothan village in Seoni district on the occasion of Shivratri. There is a natural cave covered with greenery besides a lake near the Mela venue. You have to guess the name of the fair



- 54. This fair is held in the month of November -December in Porsa village of district Morena. This fair is held in the memory of a saint who was a contemporary of Mughal Emperor Akbar. Earlier, monkeys were sold in this fair but nowadays all type of animals are sold and bought in this fair. You have to write the name of the fair.
- 55. In the Sewda village of district Datia, a fair is held annually in the in the month of October November. It is believed that the sons of lord Brahma, Sanak Sanandan and Sanatan and Sanat Kumar had meditated here. This place is also known as *Sanat Kup* close by is the place of meditation of Narad Muni also. You have to guess the name of the fair.

Bows and arrows are there traditional weapons and *bhagoria* is an important festival. Their place of residence is called *phalya*. Their main dances are :*Doha*, *Bhagoria* and *Gadhvi* What is the name of the tribe?
- 67. It is believed that this tribe of Madhya Pradesh has come here from southern India. Their origin is from *Bora Dev/ Mahadev* and they are related to the ancient Dravidians. *Dulhadev* is their main deity. Their farming is called *Baari* and they make cotton clothes. They are mainly found in the Chhindwara district of Madhya Pradesh. Their main folk-dance *Rina*, *Karma*, *Saila*, *Kaharwa*, *Sajani*, *Gocho and Gendi*. What is the name of the tribe?
- 68. This tribe of Madhya Pradesh live mainly on the bank of Narmada, Shon and Chambal river, mainly near the Vindhya and Kaimur mountain ranges. They worship Sun, moon the wind and Lord Indra. They believe in black magic. They are fond of music and don't have any mark of their *gotra*. Their main folk dance is *Kaul Dehki*. What is the name of the tribe?
- 69. This tribe originally belongs to the Dravidian group and the literal meaning of the name means *Purohit* or priest. Their main deity is *Budha Dev* who is believed to reside on *Saj* tree. *Thakur Dev* is the lord of land. To safeguard from diseases, they worship *Dulhadev*. The image of *pardhan* is kept on their place of worship. Their main folk dances are *Bimla, Pardhoni, Dussehra, Atari, Suva* and *Sua*. *Muqaddam* is their chief. What is the name of the tribe?
