Annexure 14 Conditions for Consortium

In case the Bidder is a Consortium, it shall comply with the following additional requirements:

- 1. The Bidder may be a Proprietorship firm /partnership firm/ Company as single entity or a group of entities (the "Consortium"), joining together to implement the Project. However, no Bidder applying individually or as a member of a Consortium, as the case may be, can be member of another Bidder. The term Bidder used herein would apply to both a single entity and a Consortium.
- 2. A Bidder may be a single entity or any combination of them with a formal intent to enter into an agreement or under an existing agreement to form a Consortium. A Consortium shall be eligible for consideration.
- 3. No Special purpose Vehicle (SPV) shall be allow for consortium.
- 4. All the members of the consortium shall meet individually the financial requirement criteria given at 12.2 (2)(turnover).
- 5. Combined technical capability of all the members will be considered.
- 6. Bank guarantee is to be submitted by the lead member only.
- 7. MPTB will do all correspondence with lead member only.
- 8. MPTB will make all the payments to lead member only.
- 9. Number of members in a consortium shall not exceed 2 (two);
- 10. Subject to the provisions of clause (a) above, the Proposal should contain the information required for each member of the Consortium;
- 11. Members of the Consortium shall nominate one member as the lead member (the "Lead Member"). The nomination(s) shall be supported by a Power of Attorney, as per the format annexed, signed by all the other members of the Consortium;
- 12. The Proposal should include a brief description of the roles and responsibilities of individual members, particularly with reference to financial and technical obligations in this RFP;
- 13. An individual Bidder cannot at the same time be member of a Consortium applying for qualification.
- 14. Further, a member of a particular Bidder Consortium cannot be member of any other Bidder Consortium applying for qualification;
- 15. Members of the Consortium shall enter into a binding Joint Bidding Agreement, substantially in the form specified in annexure (the "Jt. Bidding Agreement"), for the purpose of submitting a Bid. The Jt. Bidding Agreement, to be submitted along with the Proposal.
- 16. A Bidder bidding individually or as a member of a Consortium shall not be entitled to submit another bid either individually or as a member of any Consortium, as the case may be.
- 17. Change in the composition of a Consortium will not be permitted by the Authority during the Bidding process.
- 18. No change in consortium members shall be allowed till the validity of the agreement
- 19. The lead member shall be continue during entire contract period. In case of legal incapacity the legal heirs of the lead member will continue the contract.

 - (iv) violate any clearance, permit, Development Right, grant, license or other governmental authorization, approval, judgment, order or decree or any mortgage agreement, indenture or any other instrument to which such Party is a party or by which such Party or any of its properties or assets are bound or that is otherwise applicable to such Party; or
